Garrett and Anna Brewer serve at Jocko Valley Baptist Church in Arlee, Montana with their children, Lee (7) and Florence (4). Called by God to proclaim the gospel, the Brewers moved to Arlee in June 2017. Their deepest desire is to nurture a local church that grows in truth, love, and grace, fostering disciples who make disciples in the Valley and across the nations. Anna, daughter of Kenny and Merrie Prewett, was raised on the Flathead Reservation as her parents planted churches in the Pablo and Arlee communities. Raised in Olive Flathead Indian Reservation Branch, Mississippi, Garrett grew up at Longview Heights Baptist

Church. Married in 2010, Garrett served on the pastoral staff at Redeemer Baptist Church in Olive Branch from 2010 to 2017 before answering the call to Montana. He is the lead pastor at JVBC.

Church Growth and Unity: Pray for spiritual growth within the congregation, that members would deepen in faith, unity, and a passion for discipleship, impacting Jocko Valley and the nations for Christ. Ministry and Financial Partnership: Pray for new partnerships with like-minded local churches and individuals to support Jocko Valley Baptist Church's mission. Pray specifically for God to provide financial provision, enabling Pastor Garrett to


